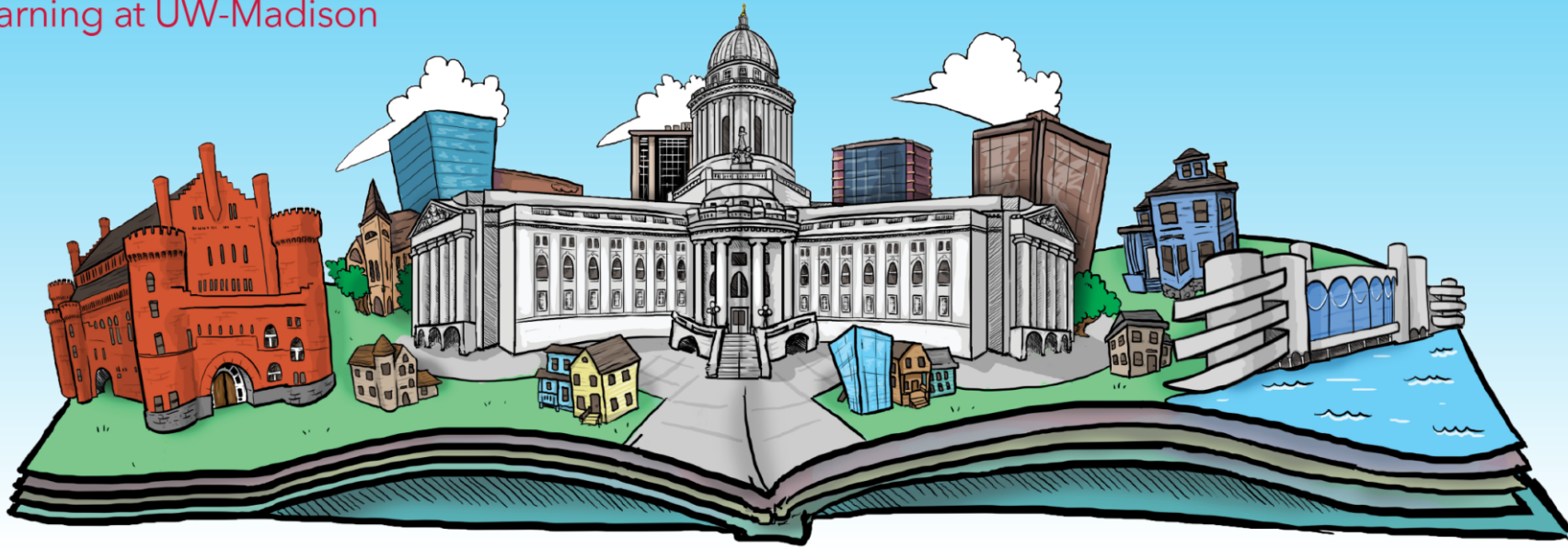
Badger Volunteers
