








#### **Evaluation is:**

"the **systematic** acquisition and assessment of **information** to **provide useful feedback** about some object" – Trochim 2006

#### In other words....

Bringing more information to a question, so you can answer it and use it!




"Evaluative Thinking... involves skills such as identifying assumptions, posing thoughtful questions, pursuing deeper understanding through reflection and perspective taking and making informed decisions in preparation for action." - Tom Archibald









### The Nonprofit Evaluation Roadmap







What the work looks like


What we want to see happen

# TWO: What information will answer the question?



#### Consider....

- 1. What does "success" look like when we've achieved it?
  - OR: How have we recognized success in the past? What tells us we're making a difference?
- 2. How do we know we're making progress?
  - •OR: How do we know when we're on the right path?
    - → Engage Stakeholders
    - → Think #s AND Stories




#### **#EVALHACK:**

Where and when are people thinking about this program already? How it's doing and how it could improve?

- Staff or volunteer meetings?
- Program celebrations? Kick-off or wrap-up activities?
  - → Embed a discussion in a meeting
- → Facilitate a group activity --- we love post-its!
  - → Have some "sidebar" conversations





# **THREE:** How do we get this information?\*

\*And not disrupt everything in the process or miss opportunities!

- √ Focus groups
  - ✓Interviews
  - ✓ Observation



#### #EVALHACK: LEVERAGE

Where does information (data) already live in our organization?

- Participant records or registrations
- Budgets and financial records
- Sign-in or attendance sheets
- Meeting agenda and minutes
- Google Analytics, email marketing data
- ???



#### #EVALHACK: ALIGN

What are we already doing that could connect to information-gathering?

- Meetings, celebrations, gatherings of stakeholders
- Debriefing, reflection activities
- Planning, calendaring
- Communication activities
- Asking participants to apply their learning
- ???




#### #EVALHACK: ENGAGE

Who is also involved in this effort and how do we engage with them (or want to)?

- Meeting topics
- Group process
- Asking for input and insights --- Can I take you to coffee?
- How are you evaluating this? (ENGAGE + ALIGN)
- ???



# FIVE: How do we apply this answer to our work?




#### Let's go back to TWO's #EVALHACK:

  - What questions do we have now....?






